47th ANNUAL SPRING TENNESSEE CRAFT FAIR *Celebration of Craft is a 'Must Do' Event*

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (March 29, 2018) – Nashville’s premiere craft event returns to Centennial Park for the 47th Annual Spring Tennessee Craft Fair, May 4, 5 & 6. Twice yearly, Tennessee Craft produces top-notch, juried, exhibition events worth attending, featuring art worth owning from artists worth supporting. Attracting 45,000 visitors each fair, Tennessee Craft Fairs are top tier shows that bring together craft artists with regional and national reputations to share their best work. Connect with acclaimed makers, watch live demonstrations, and shop local for one-of-a-kind handmade gifts in the iconic Centennial Park, along West End Avenue.

Meet up-and-coming artists at Tennessee Craft's Emerging Makers tent. This unique opportunity introduces new artists to the community while showcasing their artwork during the 3-day fair. The public is invited to bring future artists to the Publix Kids' Tent, featuring a variety of hands-on activities supported by the Community Foundation of Middle Tennessee and led by our community partners: Conexion Americas, Hatch Show Print, Nashville Public Library, Turnip Green Creative Reuse, Andrew Jackson’s Hermitage, Frist Center for the Visual Arts, Watkins College of Art, and Country Museum Hall of Fame and Museum.

The Spring Tennessee Craft Fair will be open Friday and Saturday from 10 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. and Sunday from 10 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. CST. As always, this event is free and open to the public with free parking and a free shuttle service on Saturday and Sunday. Shuttle will run in 15-minute loops from the HCA Parking Lots located on Park Plaza to the Tennessee Craft Fair. All guests are encouraged to use this free service that is generously provided by the Metropolitan Airport Authority. You can get to Centennial Park on Metro Transit Authority bus routes: West End #3, Charlotte #10, and University Connector #21.
