HOW to Get Involved

- 1. PLAN Plan an activity in your community (a demo, lecture, exhibit, etc.) or an end-of-week celebration!
- **2. PARTICIPATE –** Sign up to participate in an existing event that showcases Tennessee artists.
- 3. **REACH OUT –** Register your event at <u>www.tennesseecraft.org/tennessee-craft-week</u> by JULY 15 and send us your media contacts: we'll help you with promotions and sending out press releases
- **4. DOCUMENT and SHARE –** Take photos, record estimates or sales generated, attendance at events, etc. so that we can expand our promotion of YOU!

WHY Get Involved?

- 1. VISIBILITY More participants means more attention, and TCW runs concurrently with American Craft Week (ACW). ACW is a national marketing effort for making the fine craft community noticeably more visible during this time.
- 2. **TOGETHER** Tennessee Craft chapters' activities are promoted together, and all craft artists have the opportunity to participate in this statewide event.
