**What:** Approximately 200 emerging and experienced makers from across the nation will exhibit unique, handcrafted goods at the 36th Annual Fall Tennessee Craft Fair. Invited artists will be showing their craft to an estimated 50,000 attendees at one of the most highly regarded craft shows in the region. Fairgoers will come all weekend to purchase one-of-a-kind work, meet the artists and to learn about the fine craft tradition. **Who:** The Fall Tennessee Craft Fair is open to anyone who wishes to apply. There are no residency requirements. All work must be original in concept and design and be executed by the artist. Scoring is based on technical and artistic excellence and originality.

**Presenter:** The Tennessee Association of Craft Artists (TACA) is now Tennessee Craft. Since 1965 the organization has worked to continue and create Tennessee’s fine craft tradition.
